We will continue to reevaluate on a week to week basis. Please continue to check our various methods of communication weekly. We have prayerfully decided to cancel all church related activities through April 4th including the Easter Egg Hunt. There is the potential to have the egg hunt at later date in a different fashion.

Although we could not gather together in person yesterday, we remain united in our commitment to our faith and to our community. We encourage you to continue to be the church during this time of uncertainty. Some of the members of our church are going through difficult times due to stress or health or finances or any number of needs. If you need help or want to help others, please reach out to the church office or Pastor Eric. We would like to connect those who need help with those in our church family who would like to help.

With all the uncertainty and out of a desire to be cautious, we don't know when we will be able to gather together again. We ask that those who are able continue to support our church operations to please mail your offering checks to the church. We cannot accept walk in donations out of concern for everyone's health. We are also encouraging the Congregation NOT come to the Church during this period of closure except for the people that may really need too i.e. Sexton for extra cleaning purposes / checking on the systems and the Pastor & Administrative Staff on a limited basis, etc.

We ask that you continue to pray for good health and safety of our church family. Please also pray for leadership as we seek God's wisdom. Please pray that the COVID-19 pandemic subsides quickly, and we can soon resume meeting as a church in person. Pray for those in government leadership as they make hard decisions. Pray for your neighbors, friends, family, the elderly, and anyone who is currently diagnosed with this virus. And pray that God will use this as an opportunity to help us find new ways to reach our community with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and help more people flourish in their faith journey.
